After the reboot, the HWREN25 will join the original network. It will have the same network name as the original wireless network, unless it was renamed otherwise during the set up process. If you wish to modify this name, please refer to the user manual.

It is important that you place the HWREN25 where it still can receive signal from the original wireless source. In most cases, place it between the original wireless source and your desired location.

Make sure the Extender is placed in a location where it can receive a strong signal from your desired wireless Internet connection. The Extender will not work without a signal it can repeat.
